## 'I Can't Wait to Rape You:' NH Man Arrested for Texting Threats

SELINGROVE, Pennsylvania — A New Hampshire man is being held on \$50,000 cash bail after texting an undercover officer "I'm going to kill you," police said.

Guy Wishart, of Lincoln, was arrested and charged with three counts of felony terroristic threats with intent to terrorize another, one count of terroristic threats cause serious public inconvenience and one count of stalking - repeatedly commit acts to cause fear.

He was arraigned Monday on the charges.

These charges come after he pleaded guilty in January to dissemination of intimate images involving a student at Susquehanna University with whom he previously had a relationship.

Court documents state that Wishart registered at the Holiday Inn Express in Selinsgrove, Pennsylvania, for Jan. 8 but did not show.

The victim contacted police Feb. 7 and said she was receiving electronic messages from an unidentified person. It was inferred that the source of the messages was Wishart because the information was only known to the victim and Wishart.

That day police began investigating by communicating with Wishart undercover online and exchanged phone numbers with him.

Contact continued through March 5 to either the victim herself or to the undercover officer.

On Feb. 9, Wishart admitted to the undercover officer he knew where the victim frequented local establishments and that he planned on visiting Selinsgrove the weekend of March 4, court documents state.

On Feb. 26, court documents state that Wishart confirmed his plans to visit Selinsgrove from March 4-12.

On Feb. 27, the suspect began making threats to the undercover police officer via electronic messaging under the impression that the person he was communicating with was a friend of the victim.

In addition to numerous calls from different phone numbers, some messages the undercover number received were "I'm going to kill you," "You f\*\*\*\*\* with the wrong person," and "You made a really big mistake, I'm in Subury right now."

Simultaneously, the victim received messages including "I love you" from spoofed numbers.

An example of these messages can be seen in the text exchange conversation below that took place Feb. 28, according to court documents.

VICTIM: Who is this?

NUMBER: Do you miss us at all?

VICTIM: I'm sorry who is this? You might have the wrong number

NUMBER: I guess I do. I was looking for (victim) and is this (victim)?

VICTIM: Yes, is this Guy?

NUMBER: No way.

VICTIM: So who is this?

NUMBER: I love you I hope all is awesome. How are you.

VICTIM: Can I know who this is before I indulge in a conversation?

NUMBER: You know who this is. If you don't want to talk just say so and I will not bother you again babe. Do you ever think about us. Are you going on a trip for SB?

Court documents say on March 1-4 messages from a spoofed number to the undercover number included threats saying "I can't wait to rape you," "I'm going to f\*\*\* you and cut your throat. Then I'm going to do the same to all your friends," "I'll see you in the morning c\*\*\*." The friends referenced in the messages also are students at the university.

Police also discovered Wishart made reservations on his credit card at the Holiday Inn Express in Shamokin Dam, Pennsylvania, for March 4-8.

Wishart even posted on his Facebook page March 5 that he was at the hotel though it was later learned he canceled that reservation.

Also on that day, the University Public Safety Department issued a Clery public safety warning to the campus community of a potential threat to students, on behalf of those threatened.

Snyder County Adult Probation contacted New Hampshire police to help with the investigation. Police then contacted Wishart and gained access to his phone, **finding out/coming** contacts that matched the numbers of the victim and the undercover number.

The suspect was subsequently detained by New Hampshire authorities March 5. Since then, the undercover number has not received any communication, police said.

His previous conviction stems from an incident when Wishart posted explicit images of the victim on a fraternity Facebook page in May 2017.

"Wishart has been texting her father, who is located in New Hampshire, vulgar messages and also creating a fake Facebook account using her name and trying to speak with her friends," the affidavit states.

According to Wishart, the relationship ended in February 2017, and he described it to NH1 in June as a "bad breakup."

"I didn't do this," Wishart said in June. "I haven't been contacted by the police in Pennsylvania whatsoever. The only way I knew was because when (NH1) followed up on the story from Pennsylvania and put it on Facebook, everyone was like 'Dude what the hell's going on?' and I was like, 'I have no idea.'"

After his guilty plea, he was sentenced to 24 months probation. The most recent alleged contact with the victim violates his sentence conditions.

He is next scheduled to appear in the Selinsgrove district court April 2.
